Congress of Vienna

Napoleon fought in the wars which bear his name – Napoleonic – for over 20 years. After being defeated by the Nations of Great Britain, Prussia, Austria, and Russia in the Battle of Leipzig, Napoleon was exiled and his empire was divided up among the four victors.
