Dress: All delegates and student advisors must be appropriately dressed for this conference at all times. This means, at minimum, a dress shirt, tie, slacks, socks and shoes for boys, and a blouse/skirt combination, dress, or pants suit for girls, along with appropriate footwear. No bare midriffs, severely short skirts/dress, or revealing blouses will be permitted. Boys must keep their ties on at all time unless given permission to in committee (due to heat). They must, however, be put back on when outside committee. Students in inappropriate dress will be disciplined and/or dismissed from the conference with a loss of MUN hours.

Behavior: All MUN students must follow mature behavior standards. Inappropriate behavior will result in discipline, dismissal from the conference with loss of MUN hours, and possible dismissal from the MUN program. Inappropriate behavior includes leaving the Tustin campus, wandering around out of committee, going into other committee rooms, slacking off, etc.

Conference and Extra Credit: This conference fulfills the conference obligation for the Independent student. **YOU MUST ATTEND THE CONFERENCE FOR BOTH DAYS TO GET FULL CREDIT.** If you do not, you will be asked to either fulfill this obligation with a written assignment or attend Mission Viejo or University of Chicago instead.

This conference fulfills one of two conference obligations for the novice classes.

A maximum of four independent student advisor positions are needed for Saturday. Two are needed on Sunday. Two media positions are needed as well—one for Saturday, the other for Sunday. This will fulfill your MUN IS “extra” work.

Awards include research, commendation, outstanding, and best delegate awards. Points will also be given for delegation awards to everyone belonging to the honored nation in General Assembly, ECOSOC, or Specialized Committee (unless they give out a general award—then everyone in that delegation gets points).

Our goal is 4 gavels and a delegation award! Let’s do it!

Early Dismissal: No delegate may leave this conference except in the case of a medical or home emergency unless a signed note has been given by the Friday before the conference. A loss of credit or hours will be given for those who turn in notes after this time.
