

# Whitney High School MUN Prep Conference Information Sheet

The Whitney High School MUN invites you to its annual novice Prep Model United Nations Conference on **Saturday, October 7.**

**Costs and Deadlines:** The Whitney conference is free to every delegate.

**Transportation and Check-in.** Because this event is at Whitney High School itself there will be no bus transportation provided to this conference. Arrange in advanced for transportation to the school and back home. Arrive at the Whitney campus at 8:45 am, register and meet in the front entrance of the school. Delegates who don't check in cannot receive their MUN credit.

**Conference Schedule** (subject to change):

- Arrive at Whitney High School / Registration (8:30-9:00)
- Opening Ceremonies (9:00 to 9:30)
- Committee Session I (9:30 to Noon)
- Lunch (Noon to 12:30) Lunch will not be provided. Bring your own.
- Committee Session II (12:30 to 2:00)
- Closing Session (2:00 to 2:30)

**Dress:** All delegates and student advisors must be appropriately dressed for this conference at all times. This means, at minimum, a dress shirt, tie, slacks, socks and shoes for boys, and a blouse/skirt combination, dress, or pants suit for girls, along with appropriate footwear. No bare midriffs, severely short skirts/dress, or revealing blouses will be permitted. Boys must keep their ties on at all time unless given permission to in committee (due to heat). They must, however, be put back on when outside committee. Students in inappropriate dress will be disciplined and/or dismissed from the conference with a loss of MUN hours.

**Behavior:** All MUN students must follow mature behavior standards. Inappropriate behavior will result in discipline, dismissal from the conference with loss of MUN hours, and possible dismissal from the MUN program. Inappropriate behavior includes leaving the Whitney campus, wandering around out of committee, going into other committee rooms, slacking off, etc.

**Early Dismissal:** Delegates have the right to come to this conference late or can leave early. Delegates who give Mr. Rosenberg written notification by **Friday, September 22, in class**, that they will be going to be late or have to leave the conference early, will receive MUN credit for the hours starting from the time they check in with Mr. Rosenberg and the time they check out. Students who are arriving late or leave early without written notification will lose half the MUN hours they were supposed to earn.
